

## Auditor Self-Attestation

In compliance with the <u>OCI Conformance Program</u>, OCI requires all audit firms that conduct formal third-party audits of OCI Service Providers to submit a signed and dated self-attestation. The audit firm shall submit the completed form to their client who will forward it to the OCI Steering Committee via <u>hello@oc-i.org</u>. Following the submission, OCI will publish the auditor's self-attestation.

By providing the requested information below and signing this attestation, I affirm to the best of my knowledge that my organization meets the set of minimum OCI acceptance criteria.

**Assertion 1.** My organization is in good standing.

Assertion 2. My organization can demonstrate a track record of industry-relevant audit work.

**Assertion 3.** My organization provably understands the relevant OCI Conformance Criteria, which is reflected in an audit strategy.
